Policy Statement:

The Central Washington Chapter of the AGA will periodically award educational grants to selected business/accounting/political science students whose principle residence is within Chelan, Douglas, Kittitas, Yakima or Klickitat Counties.

Guidelines:

Use: Grants may be used for books and/or tuition at any state certified two or four year school issuing an Associate, Bachelor or Graduate degrees. Such schools do not necessarily have to be within Washington State.

Selection: Applications will be reviewed and judged by a three-member selection committee; selection will be predicated upon the criterion established by this policy. The Selection Committee will present three applications and their recommendations to the Board of the Central Washington Chapter of AGA for final approval of one or more of the applications.

Balance: The Board will make every effort to balance or rotate the award(s) within the five county region, but a qualified candidate shall not be passed over for the sake of alternating recipients based on county residence.

Criterion: All applications will be judged on student potential for contribution in the financial/accounting fields; student financial need and student academic record. Highest priority will be given to student potential with need and academic record in that order.

Selection Committee: The Selection Committee will be comprised of three current members of the Central Washington Chapter of AGA; no two members may be from the same county. The Selection Committee shall receive the applications from the Secretary and will meet concurrent with a regular meeting.

Applications: Applications shall be presented/mailed to the Secretary of the Central Washington Chapter of the AGA. The Secretary shall give all applications to the Selection Committee for consideration.

From time to time, the Central Washington Chapter shall review the application format and criteria; revisions must be concurred upon by a majority of current members in attendance at the meeting during which the revisions are presented.
